Montblanc Timepieces 2017

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Inspired by performance

Ever since its earliest days, the chronograph complication has been associated with the competitive spirit of sports like few other inventions have been. First used at horse racing events, chronographs have acted as judge and jury in almost every type of sporting competition. With unerring precision, the chronograph has guarded fair play and good sportsmanship as well as spurring ambition and rivalry for ever-improving performance. The chronograph is especially linked to motor racing and has borne witness to the greatest moments in motor sports.

Honouring the chronograph's vital role in competitive driving, the Montblanc TimeWalker Collection celebrates the spirit of racing with a line of new professional watches. The collection draws inspiration from timepieces from the outstanding history of the Minerva watch manufacture. Today the home of the Montblanc Manufacture in Villeret, in its heyday Minerva was one of the leading specialists in professional watches for measuring small intervals of time with the utmost precision. Its heritage is perfectly exemplified by the renowned "Rally Timer",


a stopwatch that was created in 1960 to precisely time motor racing results.

With a 43 mm case size, which has become a standard for Montblanc's performance timepieces, the new TimeWalker Collection represents a strong, contemporary expression of the professional sport chronograph. From the case to the dial, from the movement to the complications, the collection focuses masculine energy in a vintage-themed yet contemporary style, while combining performance and innovation with high legibility and robustness.

The aesthetic codes of the new TimeWalker timepieces are directly rooted in the world of racing with satinated cases featuring semi-skeletonised horns and knurled sides on a black bezel. Crown and pushers are reminiscent of the petrol tank caps of classic racing cars, while the highly readable dials with three-dimensional counters are inspired by vintage car dashboards. Encapsulating Minerva's heritage with superb technology embodying the glory days of racing, Montblanc announces the rebirth of these professional watches. With the new Montblanc TimeWalker Chronograph 1.000, which measures up to 1/1000th of a second, the Maison brings a new level of performance and innovation to the TimeWalker Collection.

Celebrating the sport's passion and moments of glory, the new TimeWalker Collection elegantly embodies the spirit of racing.

Developed alongside racing pursuits, the chronograph soon became both a guardian of fair play and a stimulus for ever-faster performance in motor racing.



Legitimacy of the past

With the rise of motor racing in the early 20th century, new engines and lighter car bodies led to faster and faster speeds every year. As the winners were determined by slimmer and slimmer margins, the need for chronometric devices that could measure even smaller intervals was more acute than ever. Among the leading specialists in precise chronometry who were up to the task was the manufacture that is now home to the Montblanc Manufacture in Villeret – the Minerva Maison founded in 1858.

The manufacture developed stopwatches that could measure 1/5th of a second as early as 1911, rapidly increasing to 1/10th of a second. In this innovative spirit, in 1916 the Minerva manufacture was one of the first to develop a high-frequency movement that could measure 1/100th of a second, an achievement that was further improved in 1936, putting Minerva on the map as a specialist in professional watches and stopwatches for the Olympic games.

Trailblazing timekeeping technology with innovative patents, Minerva shaped the history of performance timing in a way that few other watch manufactures did. Hand-crafted in the small village of Villeret, nestled in the Swiss Jura mountains, the manufacture's stopwatches were present at legendary sporting events around the world, accurately measuring the latest triumphs of their glorious heroes. Paying tribute to Minerva's extraordinary heritage, Montblanc journeys back to the glory days of motor racing with timing instruments that capture the beauty, spirit and values of motor racing history. Professional watches are reborn, enhancing their performance and innovation for the new TimeWalker Collection.

The Montblanc TimeWalker Collection honours the spirit of racing by offering a line of new professional watches inspired by the Minerva legacy, including a re-edition of the famous Minerva Rally Timer.

The horologic legacy of the Montblanc Manufactures

Centuries of collected knowledge, decades of experience, years of development and hundreds of hours of dedicated labour – they all culminate in a Montblanc timepiece coming to life. With their skills and knowledge handed down through generations, the watchmakers at the Montblanc Manufactures in Villeret and Le Locle put their pride, passion and soul into each timepiece.

Villeret's watchmaking tradition began almost 160 years ago, when in 1858 Charles-Yvan Robert founded a watch workshop in a small village in the Saint-Imier valley. Under the name Minerva, the company gained worldwide recognition for its precise chronometry and became a leading specialist in the production of professional watches. Capable of measuring time accurately to 1/100th of a second in 1916, its mechanical stopwatches were fundamental to the evolution of modern-day motor racing.

The Montblanc Manufacture in Villeret.

As the former home of Minerva, the Montblanc Manufacture in Villeret upholds the manufacture's legacy of expertise. Here, Montblanc's Movement & Innovation Excellence Centre continues to enrich fine Swiss watchmaking with groundbreaking innovations. Following in the footsteps of Minerva, the watchmakers developed a chronograph that measures accurately to 1/1000th of a second.

This watchmaking expertise gained from high complications is also applied to the creation of highly functional small complications. In the Manufacture's ateliers, all the movements' components are carefully crafted and decorated by hand using traditional methods. The watchmakers chamfer every edge, polish even the tiniest wheel and adorn plates and bridges with the traditional circular graining and "Côtes de Genève" stripes. Their great dexterity and skill are also indispensable in crafting delicate balance springs, an accomplishment only very few watch manufactures manage.

Manifested in a superior level of craftsmanship and timelessly elegant design codes, the Manufacture's horological knowledge is deeply embedded in all Montblanc timepieces, passing on the passion for fine watchmaking from grand complication timepieces to refined three-hand watches.

Tested for utmost precision and absolute perfection

The Montblanc Manufacture in Le Locle – the Maison’s Watch & Quality Excellence Centre – is where the final assembly of Montblanc timepieces takes place. Once the carefully orchestrated interplay of countless delicate parts is perfected, all the timepieces undergo the rigorous testing procedure of the Montblanc Laboratory Test 500.

For 500 hours, the timepieces are subjected to a variety of extreme conditions: the wear and tear of daily life, numerous settings and re-settings of the crown, different climatic conditions, as well as use of all their specific functions. The performance testing of the TimeWalker Chronograph UTC, the TimeWalker Chronograph Automatic and the TimeWalker Date Automatic also ensures water resistance of up to 100 metres.

Only after passing the test – assured by the Montblanc Laboratory Test 500 certificate – are the timepieces released for delivery. Worthy of Montblanc’s strictest and highest quality standards, they are destined to become fine lifetime companions.

Only once the quality-assurance team at the Montblanc Manufacture in Le Locle is convinced that a watch upholds Montblanc’s strict quality standards do they release it for subsequent delivery. Each watch that passes the Montblanc Laboratory Test 500 is issued with an individual test certificate.

Montblanc TimeWalker Chronograph 1.000 Limited Edition

The spirit of racing – ceaselessly striving to break records that seem unbreakable – drove Minerva’s engineers in 1916 to develop a stopwatch capable of measuring time to 1/100th of a second, a development that was surpassed in 1936. Now, Montblanc pushes innovation even further with a new timepiece offering ten-fold precision: a chronograph precise to 1/1000th of a second.

Its manufacture calibre MB *M*66.26 combines two balance wheels: one with 18,000 semi-oscillations or 2.5 Hz – visible at 7 o’clock – for the time indication, and one, with 360,000 semi-oscillations or 50 Hz, for the chronograph function at 10 o’clock. The theoretical frequency of 500 Hz required to measure 1/1000th of a second is achieved by combining the 50 Hz chronograph balance wheel with a “mobile de millième”, which rotates ten times per second to subdivide the 1/100th of a second into increments of ten. As on vintage Minerva stopwatches, the chronograph’s monopusher is positioned at 12 o’clock.

Inspired by motor sports, the indication for the 1/1000th of a second at 12 o’clock resembles a vintage car speedometer, and the chronograph’s power reserve recalls historical fuel gauges. The tribute continues with the knurled crown, red gasket and black alligator-skin strap with red-lined holes and stitching. Light yet robust, the 46.4 mm case is made of satinated titanium with black DLC coating.

Indicated at 3 o’clock, the chronograph function’s own barrel has a power reserve to continuously measure up to 45 minutes. However, to indefinitely extend this limit, the power reserve can be refreshed by turning the crown anticlockwise, even while the chronograph is running.



Montblanc TimeWalker Chronograph Rally Timer Counter

Reinterpreting Minerva's historical Rally Timer, Montblanc presents an innovative and versatile timepiece. It can be used in different ways, as it can also be changed from a wristwatch into a pocket watch or a dashboard clock. The manufacture calibre **MB *M*16.29** with a monopusher chronograph was inspired by the original Minerva calibre **MB 17.29** from the 1930s, offering hand-crafted fine watchmaking finishes such as chamfered angles and "Côtes de Genève" or circular graining decorations. As with all the Minerva calibres, one of the movement's components is shaped into the form of the Minerva arrow to pay tribute to the Manufacture's heritage.

As on the famous Minerva Rally Timer, the chronograph's 30-minute counter at 12 o'clock is vertically aligned with the small seconds subdial at 6 o'clock. With a tip sculpted after the Minerva arrow, the red chronograph second hand runs in central position along a tachymeter scale, which can be used to calculate speeds over fixed distances. The historical Arabic numerals and the precise minuterie with red accents at five-minute markings were also modelled after its predecessor.

With the same dimensions as its famous predecessor, the satinated titanium case with knurled finishing and DLC coating on the flank boasts an unusually large diameter of 50 mm.

Inspired by the original Minerva Rally Timer stopwatch, this versatile timepiece offers different ways of appreciating the time, with the possibility of transforming the wristwatch into a pocket watch or a dashboard clock.



Montblanc TimeWalker Automatic Chronograph UTC

Imbued with a dynamic spirit, the performance of this chronograph meets the useful functionality of a UTC complication with three time zones in a timepiece of masculine elegance.

The chronograph of the calibre **MB 25.03** measures elapsed minutes and hours at 12 and 6 o'clock as well as elapsed seconds with the iconic red hand in central position, whose tip is shaped in the form of the Minerva arrow. A dark central hand with a luminescent, red-framed arrow indicates a second time zone on the 24-hour scale of the black ceramic bezel with silvery-white numerals. Without losing the minutes, the second time zone can be adjusted through the crown in hourly increments. A third time zone can be easily indicated by turning the unidirectional rotating bezel with the location of the 24-hour hand as the point of reference.

From the dial to the flange, the colour contrast between black and silvery-white with red accents enhances readability and underlines performance. The satinated 43 mm case with black DLC coating offers water resistance of up to 100 metres and can be worn with either a leather or rubber strap. With an asymmetrical hole pattern on the outside, the latter's raised interior grip pattern improves adhesion to the wrist and breathability, and its specially developed new triple-folding clasp offers flexibility and maximum comfort.

A dark hand with luminescent red-framed arrow tip marks a second time zone, while a third can be indicated on the rotating ceramic bezel. Adjustments of the local time can be set via the crown without losing the minutes.



Montblanc TimeWalker Chronograph Automatic

Accenting dynamic performance, this timepiece with a prominent contrast of black and silvery-white takes its inspiration from racing car instruments. Its calibre MB 25.07 comprises a chronograph complication and small seconds at 9 o'clock.

From the central chronograph seconds to the vertically aligned 30-minute and 12-hour counters at 12 and 6 o'clock, the silvery-white scales are enhanced with a precise minute track, Super-LumiNova® coating and red 15-minute markings to ensure perfect readability on the black dial both day and night. The chronograph's iconic red second hand with a tip in the shape of the Minerva arrow stands out from the rhodium-plated dauphine hour and minute hands. By turning the black ceramic bezel with knurled flank finish, a second time can be marked.

Water-resistant for up to 100 metres, the 43 mm stainless steel case with satin finishing also evokes the spirit of motor racing with its semi-skeletonised horns inspired by the aerodynamic lines of classic car bodies. In addition to the leather and stainless steel wristbands, the rubber strap comes with asymmetrical holes like those of racing gloves and a raised grip pattern on the inside for better adhesion to the wrist and breathability. Its specially developed new triple-folding clasp offers flexibility and maximum comfort on the wrist.

Both crown and pusher inserts as well as the rotating ceramic bezel feature knurled finishing on the sides for a better grip. Its emblematic, red arrow-tipped second hand and red minute markings ensure utmost readability.



Montblanc TimeWalker Date Automatic

The masculine, performance-driven appeal of the TimeWalker Collection matches perfectly with the competitive world of car racing, where innovation, determination and courage carve the path to victory.

Inspired by the simplicity and clarity of vintage automotive speedometers, this timepiece's dial is focussed on essential time indication through the strong contrast between silvery-white and black. Large Arabic numerals and the Super-LumiNova® coated hands and minuterie provide perfect readability, with the iconic central second hand first catching the eye with its red colour and prominent Minerva arrow at the tip. Clearly reminiscent of early 20th century Minerva stopwatches, the scale stretches from 05 to 60, which underlines the racing lineage of the timepiece. The date indication is located close to the 15-minute numeral at 3 o'clock. The shiny, black ceramic bezel with hour numerals and indexes can be turned unidirectionally to indicate a second time zone. For a better grip, it boasts a knurled finish on the side, inspired by the petrol tank caps of vintage racing cars.

Featuring a 41 mm satinated stainless steel case with semi-skeletonised horns, which offers water resistance to 100 m for maximum reliability and performance, the timepiece can be worn with a black rubber or leather strap with asymmetrical holes or a new, high-performance three-link stainless steel wristband.

Essential time and date indication as well as functional readability are highlighted through a strong colour contrast and large Arabic minute numerals.

Rarely used in the world of fine watchmaking, Montblanc presents a collection of timepieces with cases made of bronze. Its specially researched alloy will evolve over the years to develop a unique and attractive patina. Its subtly changing colour further enriches the vintage design inspired by Minerva chronographs from the 1930s.

Leading the collection is the 1858 Chronograph Tachymeter, limited to 100 pieces. Its calibre MB \mathcal{M} 16.29 exhibits hand-crafted finishes such as chamfered angles and “Côte de Genève” guilloché decorations and – for the first time – features red gold-coloured components, thereby perfectly matching the bronze material and vintage appeal of the timepiece while also reinforcing its monochrome look. As the name of the timepiece implies, the central chronograph second hand runs along a tachymeter scale, which allows the computing of speeds over defined distances.

The dial layout with small seconds at 9 o'clock and the chronograph 30-minute counter at 3 o'clock were inspired by the 1930s Minerva chronograph – a legacy also emphasised by the champagne-coloured dial with sunray finishing, cathedral-shaped hands and vintage Montblanc crown. The 44 mm fully satinated bronze case features an onion-shaped crown and a cognac-coloured alligator-skin strap with satinated, bronze-plated buckle.

Red gold plating and bronze are in perfect harmony in the view of the manufacture movement through the sapphire glass case back. The V-shaped chronograph bridge and the characteristic Minerva arrow highlight the rich horological legacy of the timepiece.

Featuring the manufacture calibre MB *M*16.62, this innovative timepiece combines two of the most significant chronometric complications: a split-seconds chronograph and Montblanc's patented ExoTourbillon with stop-seconds mechanism.

With an additional chronograph second hand – the rattrapante, from the French for “to catch up” – the split-seconds chronograph is able to measure different times in sequence. When the pusher at 2 o'clock is pressed, the central rattrapante hand in blued steel stops at the elapsed seconds while the red gold-plated second hand continues to run. To time another interval, the rattrapante hand realigns with the running second hand via the same pusher. The ExoTourbillon at 12 o'clock ensures perfect isochronism, thanks to its special construction whereby the balance wheel is isolated from the inertia of the tourbillon cage.

While the ExoTourbillon's double-infinity bridge is bevelled by hand, the subdials and counters of the silvery-white grené dial also impress with finely worked artisanal finishes. The small seconds subdial at 9 o'clock and the chronograph 30-minute counter at 3 o'clock both feature an azuré finish in the centre and an opaline finish on the outer edge. The second time zone subdial with sunray finish at 6 o'clock is linked to the day/night indication between 4 and 5 o'clock. The dial's sophisticated elegance is complemented by the 47 mm case made of 18 K red gold.

The timepiece's split-seconds chronograph is able to measure different times in sequence. For each measurement, the pusher at 2 o'clock stops the blued steel rattrapante hand at the elapsed seconds. With the same pusher it is set ready for the next measurement, as it realigns with the continuously running, red gold-plated chronograph second hand.

In tribute to the horological heritage of the Montblanc Manufacture in Villeret, this timepiece not only combines two of the most significant chronometric complications, it also exemplifies the Manufacture's legacy of refined craftsmanship.

The ExoTourbillon oscillates precisely at 6 o'clock. For improved isochronism, its balance wheel runs in isolation from the tourbillon cage. With a quick stop-seconds mechanism, it can be halted to set the second hand precisely. The Montblanc manufacture calibre MB *R*230 also includes a double-barrel monopusher chronograph with column wheel and vertical coupling. Two semi-circular counters at 4 and 8 o'clock – each with two hands of different lengths and colours for the two sectorial scales – tally the elapsed seconds and minutes.

The dial reflects both complications with distinctly different, skilfully worked decorations. While the upper part gleams mysteriously in refined aventurine with a central “flinqué” decoration adorned with the Montblanc diamond emblem, the tourbillon is surrounded by a black rhodium-plated “Côtes de Genève” pattern. In elegant contrast to the black aventurine and black rhodium plating, this limited edition of 88 pieces features an 18 K red gold case as well as 18 K red gold-plated hands and tourbillon bridge.

The darkly radiant aventurine dial with its three subdials and patented Montblanc diamond overlooks the ExoTourbillon at 6 o'clock. The red gold case wreathes both in understated sophistication.

Embodying the organisation's global presence as well as providing useful functionality to cosmopolitan watch connoisseurs, Montblanc introduces a collection of timepieces dedicated to UNICEF – the United Nations Children's Fund. All two models feature Montblanc's visually arresting and easy-to-use manufacture complication Orbis Terrarum.

Named after the Latin term for earth, this timepiece presents the worldtime function on a multilayer dial. The main sapphire crystal dial shows the continents as viewed from the North Pole with 24 cities representing the different time zones. With cut-out continents, the disc displays the oceans in a light blue colour. Underneath, a second disc indicates the passing of night and day with dark blue and a gradient of yellow to green. While the central hour and minute hands indicate the local time of the city set in front of the red triangle at 6 o'clock, the current time in the remaining time zones is shown on the 24-hour ring encircling the dial.

Each limited to 500 pieces, the collection's two dial variations show the city names in either Latin or Chinese characters. The refined 41 mm case made of polished stainless steel with satinated flanks features the UNICEF logo on the case back and a blue leather wristband, inspired by the organisation's signature colour.

On the multilayer dial, cut-out continents rotate over a fascinating disc of dark blue and green-to-yellow gradients to show the passage of day and night around the world. The names of 24 cities mark their corresponding 24 time zones.
